

Parents Code of Conduct

Haverstock Fencing Club is committed to providing a caring, friendly and safe environment for all of our fencers so they can learn in a safe and secure atmosphere.

We ask that the parents of our fencers:

- Shall not do anything which is likely to intimidate, offend, insult, humiliate or discriminate against any person at an event or in training on the ground of their age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origins, nationality, parental or marital status, spiritual and religious belief, social status or sexual orientation
- Shall co-operate in ensuring that the sport is conducted in accordance with disciplined and sporting behaviour and acknowledge that it is not sufficient to rely solely upon the organisers to maintain these principles.
- Shall co-operate in ensuring that the spirit of the regulations of the sport are upheld
- Shall accept and observe the authority and decisions of referees, organisers and all other fencing disciplinary bodies
- Shall not collude in the committing of a Doping Offence as defined in the FIE/BFA doping regulations
- Shall not abuse, threaten or intimidate a referee, organiser or other official or any participant or spectator whether on or off the field of play
- Shall not use crude or abusive language or gestures towards referees, organisers or other officials or any other participants or spectators
